# Summer School Programs

## Special Education Summer School

- We had a total of 37 students in our special education summer school program. Students ranged from prekindergarten to 8th grade. Students entering prek to 4th grade received instruction in one of 3 classrooms based on grade. .
- Students in prekindergarten were provided a snack. 3rd and 4th grade students presented puppet shows/crankies to the prek-2nd grade students in an end of school celebration. Students in grades K-4 were instructed using a reading workshop model. Math and writing were also part of their curriculum.
- Our prekindergarten program had a behavioral focus to address the needs of our student population.
- We supported 4 students in our intensive resource room middle school program. The classroom consisted of 1 teacher and 4 paraeducators.
- Unique to our program this year was a 2 week program for 6 students who were entering 5th grade in the fall. Students focused on developing their reading and writing skills. The students were able to participate in the general middle school adventure learning program - which involved a ropes course challenge. These same students then attended the traditional middle school program which provided academic skill development for half their 3 hour day combined with a cooking challenge for the second part of their day.
- All programs were 4 weeks in length, M-Thursday from 9-12. Students received transportation to and from school.

# Summer School Continued

- Achievement & Challenge Camp was offered in two sessions:
  - Session I July 8<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup>
  - Session II July 22<sup>nd</sup> -August 2<sup>nd</sup>
- Total Number of Students
  - Session I had a total of 22 participating students
  - Session II had a total of 22 participating students

Each session was from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and met Monday through Thursday, for a total of eight meetings per session. This program provided students with the opportunity to receive 1.5 hours of daily targeted skill instruction in reading and writing or math, combined with 1.5 hours of experience on our high and low ropes course during session one and a cooking experience during session two.
