Below please find my report concerning various items of interest to the Town Council, staff, and the community:

Departmental Reports

- Public Works
 - From August 20, 2018 through September 8, 2018, the following parking lot and roads were reclaimed and paved: Library south parking lot, Park Road and the entrance to the Transfer Station, Bousa Road (formerly gravel), a section of Woods Road (formerly gravel), a section of West Highland Road (formerly gravel), Oak Drive (formerly gravel), Pleasant Valley Road and a section of Mansfield City Road. This was over \$700,000 of contracted work completed in 3 weeks. Public Works crews are installing driveway aprons and curbing and then backfilling with topsoil and seed where needed. The Department thanks all citizens for their patience and understanding during these projects.

 - The Mansfield Downtown Partnership hosted its 15th Annual Celebrate Mansfield Festival on Sunday, September 16.
